

Post adoption panic:

When you and your bun get home...

- 1) Put carrier on the *floor* and open the door. The bun will come out when he *feels safe* (and curious).
- 2) A litterbox, hay, green veggies, timothy pellets, crock or sipper bottle of water and a designated rabbit area are *all she needs* for now.
- 3) There will be something you won't expect, *flow* with it.
- 4) Expect her to do '*rabbity*' things. Everything she does is connected to *survival* in the wild.
- 5) So, don't take anything personally (remember, this is *all new* to him).
- 6) Give him *a month* to really settle in, feel safe and show his full range of *personality*.
